5. 2-3 TIMES THE AMOUNT OF FACTOR YOU NORMALLY NEED IN CARRY-ON LUGGAGE. IF YOU ARE TAKING THEM OUT OF THE BOX, BRING AT LEAST ONE TO SHOW SECURITY OR CUSTOMS EXACTLY WHAT YOU ARE CARRYING
